

Bibliography of Articles and Studies Related to Labyrinth Research: Supplement August 2025

The Labyrinth Society (TLS) Research Committee supports research on labyrinths and labyrinth experiences by providing a resource base and encouraging a wide variety of labyrinth-related research interests. This PDF is a Supplement to the online TLS Research Bibliography with the goal of acknowledging peripheral and anecdotal contributions to the study of labyrinths. The selection criteria includes:

- Labyrinths are described briefly or anecdotally, but are not the focus of the study
- The item is a brief anecdotal item (e.g., press release of a new labyrinth)
- The item is a review or duplicate of a Research Bibliography publication, or does not meet the standards of the Research Bibliography, but has additional value
- The article is accessible and a link, doi, ISBN, or other identifying information is provided; all links were accessed on August 4, 2025. Additional methods of accessing these resources may be available.
